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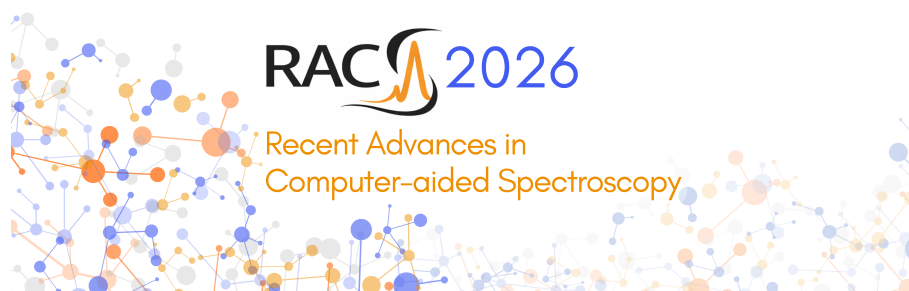


Figure 1: For small figures, you can place the caption sideways or wrap the text around figure and caption.
